Programming for players with disabilities:

While Toronto Skillz Academy does not offer direct programming for players with disabilities. We work with various organizations including schools in our community to offer programming services that will suit players with disabilities. We also work with the high schools in our community to provide volunteering opportunities for students with disabilities to be part of our game day experience during our League 1 Ontario home games

Through free soccer clinics which we hold during the late spring, summer and early fall we provide families and players with the opportunity to participate in our training programs. We are able to fund these clinics through donations from our sponsors. In addition to the free clinics we provide scholarships that allow talented players between the ages of 15 and 21 to be given roster spots on our competitive teams at no charge.

We will continue to work with community partners and local schools in order to provide opportunities to players from all economic and social backgrounds.
